## HOUSING



## PROGRAM COST \$8495

One of our biggest goals in developing GEN1:27 was to create a program that gave interns a one-of-a-kind opportunity to gain real experience in missions and ministry, develop their gifts and talents, and make a lasting impact all over the world at a price that is lower than the cost of a year at a state university.

The cost of Generation1:27 is \$8495 for the entire program and includes all of the following:

GEN1:27 is not a paid internship but we strongly believe that every dollar invested will result in a wealth of skills, experiences, and opportunities that will prepare you for success.

## CAN I HAVE A JOB WHILE IN THE PROGRAM?

In your free time during the week and on weekends, we welcome interns to find part-time job opportunities. We would advise that students plan carefully so that their schedule does not conflict with the requirements of the internship program.



## IS THIS AN ACCREDITED PROGRAM?

Our program does not yet offer college credit but is recognized by ministry leaders all over the US for its ability to prepare interns for leadership positions in missions and ministry.

## WILL THERE BE TIME OFF FROM THE PROGRAM?

GEN1:27 is a program that values consistent and productive effort that models a real position within an organization. However, we understand that time to rest and visit family is incredibly important. Throughout the year you will have scheduled breaks from the program to rest, relax, and visit family if you chose to do so.
